The **Let's Talk Communication Access Initiative** (LTCAI) has two openings for voting members on our Board of Directors beginning in September of 2020 for a two-year term. Established in 2017, LTCAI is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that supports children and adults with limited to no verbal speech to actively participate in their lives at home, at school, at work and in the community via Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) systems. In addition, the Let's Talk Communication Access Initiative provides multiple educational opportunities to support our community's understanding of disabilities and how individuals with complex needs have many abilities. Our goals are to build meaningful relationships, to support inclusive participation and to grow our community's awareness of how AAC systems support our neighbors, friends and family to engage, learn and grow.

Ideal candidates will be credible individuals with knowledge of and influence in the community, as well as having a personal interest in LTCAI's mission, educational initiatives and inclusive events. A member of LTCAI's board must have the time and interest to be an engaged and active member of the Board of Directors, and must actively develop and grow financial resources to benefit LTCAI.

A position on the LTCAI Board of Directors will provide a unique opportunity to engage in community advocacy, leadership and relationship building. In addition, board members will frequently interact and network with a variety of dynamic people. Directors are expected to attend quarterly meetings via video conference or in person and to attend the Annual Charity Gala held in January. The LTCAI Board of Director's duties include identifying avenues for generating revenue and conducting and overseeing implementation of fundraising efforts.
